CHARLOTTE - Leo Frederick Annas, 87, went to be with his Lord, Friday, Jan. 18, 2002. He had been a patient at Calais Regional Hospital since Jan. 16. He was born at Charlotte, Feb. 1 , 1914, the son of Rosie May (Fleming) and Fred John Annas. He was born and lived in the same home overlooking beautiful Round Pond and Pennamaquan Lake all his life. He was a loving husband to his late wife of 63 years, Ethel R.
